Director



Eric Foster was born and raised in Salem Church and is the son of the late Daniel and Carol Foster. He has long been an active participant in musical events due to the influence of the rich Welsh musical heritage in Venedocia. In fact, both his grandmother and mother were organists at past Gymanfi. Mr. Foster attended Ohio State University and has directed previous Gymanfi in Venedocia as well as in Michigan. He has also directed productions of the Stockbridge Festival Singers and has been a soloist with the Ingham Festival Chorus. In 2007, he retired after ten

years as director of the Mason Presbyterian Chancel choir. He also retired as Vice President of Agency Operations for the Regency Insurance Group of East Lansing, Michigan in 2007 and now resides in Dansville, Michigan with his wife Luana. They travel extensively and enjoy golfing and swing dancing.

Accompanists

Bonnie Bolton, was born and raised in the Venedocia area but has lived in New Mexico for many years. She recently retired after 45 years as a registered nurse. Ms. Bolton has been the organist for First U.M. Church in Las Vegas, NM for 21 years and at the Lady of Sorrows Catholic Church.

Connie O'Neill, grew up at Salem Church and is the daughter of the late Haydn and Marvel Lloyd. As an accomplished organist and pianist, she has performed at previous Gymanfi. Mrs. O'Neill lives in New Bremen with her husband, Kevin and her family.

Soloists



Sheila Chilcote-Collins, soprano, is an Ohio City native who enjoys performing sacred, opera, art song, and musical theatre genres of music. Over the years she has been involved in the Youth for Christ Contemporaries, Ft. Wayne Philharmonic's Summerfest Chorus, and the Heartland Festival Chorus. She also enjoys theatre, winning both local and regional awards for acting. Ms. Chilcote-Collins currently sings with the Ft. Wayne Philharmonic Chorus and is a member of the Van Wert First Presbyterian Church Women's Quartet. She is frequently a featured soloist in

area churches, special programs, and weddings in the tri-county area and beyond. She studies voice with Mr. David Van Tilburg and resides in Van Wert with her husband, Keith Collins.



Jake Wilder, is a locally known tenor and teacher in Van Wert who graduated from Bowling Green State University where he studied music performance and vocal pedagogy. While at BGSU, he studied voice privately with tenor Chris Scholl and was in numerous productions in the College of Musical Arts as principle tenor. He has had the privilege of participating in master classes with Ann Baltz of Opera Works, Margo Garrett of Julliard, and Frederic West. Hailed as a "powerful and unique timbre" by the Toledo Blade in 2011, Mr. Wilder performed a two month show tour with the Toledo Opera on Wheels and has performed as principle tenor

for productions of Handel's Messiah in Bern, Indian and in Van Wert. In 2014, he joined Heartland Sings under the direction of Maestro Robert Nance in Fort Wayne performing in the tri-state area.
