

“Jesus Saves for Us to Invest” - Matthew 25:14-30

Salem Presbyterian Church

Sunday, November 16, 2014

In today's passage, notice that the third servant, who took his master's money and buried it in the ground, did so because of fear. Fear is a common experience as Christians. I wonder how many of us fail to be the people God has called us to be, because we are afraid. Some of us are afraid of what other people will think of us. That often happens to us when we're young, but it doesn't stop with our teen years. As we get older, we may give a weak witness to our faith, because we don't want our friends to think we're some kind of religious addict.

TEACHING POINTS

Teaching Point 1: *We are accountable to invest what we have to build the Kingdom of God.*

Teaching Point 2: *Jesus calls us to be risk takers.*

Teaching Point 3: *The day of accountability is coming for what God has given us to invest.*

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

“To those who use well what they are given, even more will be given, and they will have an abundance. But from those who do nothing, even what little they have will be taken away” (Matthew 25:29 NLT).

ACTION POINT

This parable does make its point quite powerfully; it is a terrible thing to bury the gifts God has given us and not use them. There's a familiar children's song which says, "This little light of mine, I'm gonna let it shine." These short ten words have a message that is profound. The singer's light doesn't sound very big, but it is important to him, and he plans to use it. Remember! Ownership of everything is God's. Faithful management is our duty, and the time of judgment is coming!
