John in his visionary writing, in this chapter in the Book of Revelation, opens up like a mystery novel. There is a mysterious scroll. No one knows what is in the scroll. In verse two, an angel comes forth, asking, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" In verse three, this question is met with a deafening silence. For we are told about the search, "no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it." We will consider several things about Jesus from this passage:

TEACHING POINTS

POINT ONE – *We will consider His worthiness.* Jesus created all things. He went to the cross on our behalf. Christ is our King who opened the scroll and took back the earth from Satan.

POINT TWO – *We will consider His attributes.* He is as powerful as a lion. He is precious as a lamb. He is perfection.

POINT THREE – *We will know why every tongue will praise Him.* Jesus will receive the perfect worship that the perfect God should have received when He first came to earth and was not received. For all eternity, we will never forget, nor will we want to forget, how God's precious Lamb died for us.
